Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes: Students will develop skills for effectively presenting mathematics (both orally and in written exposition) to a wide variety of audiences with special emphasis on classroom situations. Students will also learn about pragmatic issues related to being a graduate student (how to select a thesis advisor, how to apply for an NSF Graduate Research Fellowship, etc.).

Assignments will consist primarily of oral and written expositions. Oral presentations will be critiqued by the class. I will read (and grade) written assignments. Final grade will be determined by performance on these assignments and by participation in class.
